

POLICY FOR USE

This policy established guidelines for restricted funds at Cardio-Facio-Cutaneous (CFC) International, including anticipated and accepted uses. While those who created the fund may be consulted, proposed use of each fund is subject to Board approval. This policy will be implemented in concert with other financial policies of CFC International. The Executive Director and the Board of Directors are responsible for ensuring that the funds are maintained and used only for the purposes described in this policy.

RESTRICTED FUND DESCRIPTIONS

Science & Research Fund

Established in 2010, this restricted fund will be used for the sole purpose of financially supporting CFC International's science/research initiatives including items outlined below:

Anticipated and Accepted Uses for the Science & Research Fund

1. CFC International Registry
2. Research grants
3. Scientific Medical Advisory Board meetings, including additional interested researchers/scientists
4. Support of the biennial International Scientific Symposium held in conjunction with the other RASopathy organizations
5. Raising awareness in scientific medical community; attendance at scientific/medical meetings

Stephanie Kohler Scholarship Fund

The Stephanie Kohler Scholarship fund provides scholarships for families to attend the biennial family conference with a preference given to first time attendees. This fund was established in 2011 by the Kohler family in memory of their daughter, Stephanie. Their generous financial support has benefited families and the CFC community.
